## ***Running jORCA in MAC OS***

jORCA pre-requisite is to have **Java 1.6 version or higher** installed in the operative system. The problem is that using MAC OS 10.5.8 version although you install the Java Virtual Machine v1.6, the default version is always 1.5.

You can check your default java version in a console with the following command:

```
java -version
```

A possible solution is upgrading the Operative System to Mac OS X 10.6.2.

Another solution is changing the default version of Java to 1.6 for a command line process. This can be done by changing your user `.bash_profile` adding the following:

```
JAVA_HOME=/System/Library/Frameworks/JavaVM.framework/Versions/1.6/  
Home  
export JAVA_HOME  
PATH=$JAVA_HOME/bin:$PATH  
export PATH
```

Now check your java version and run jORCA from the console using

```
./jORCA.sh or java -jar jORCA.jar
```
